### NEW CHILDCARE SUBSIDY THRESHOLDS & RATES:

Effective from 1st April 2024—Work & Income NZ have increased the income thresholds and rates for families. Please look online at the new thresholds as these have increased significantly to prior years, or alternatively pop in and see Julie at the office.

Existing clients: If you already receive childcare subsidy for your child you do not need to do anything as this will automatically be reviewed and any change required will be implemented.

#### FAMILY BOOST ANNOUNCEMENT:

On Monday 25<sup>th</sup> March 2024 the Government announced its intention to introduce a new childcare payment, FamilyBoost, as part of Budget 2024.

FamilyBoost is a new payment made by Inland Revenue to partially reimburse eligible families for their ECE costs.

Families would be able to claim and receive FamilyBoost reimbursements every 3 months. The first reimbursement would be paid in October 2024, covering the three-month period from 1st July—30th September 2024.

Families will need to hold on to their invoices from the centre from 1st July 2024 in order to claim the first payment.

Below is a table indicating levels of eligibility.

Household income	Maximum weekly rebate	Amount refunded, paid three-monthly
Up to \$140,000	\$75.00	\$975.00
\$150,000	\$56.25	\$731.25
\$160,000	\$37.50	\$487.50
\$170,000	\$18.75	\$243.75


Recently we have reviewed our Illness and Immunisation policy, and this will be loaded onto the Community page of StoryPark for your perusal.



A couple of points to note from the policy:

- In the event of an infectious disease outbreak, and we do not have your child's up to date immunisation record we will assume your child is not fully vaccinated and will therefore be excluded from attending. Unimmunised children would also be excluded from attending- both instances will be in conjunction with advice from the Ministry of Health.
- Measles—should a child contract measles there will be a minimum stand down of 5 days after the appearance of the rash.

In addition, we have been made aware of the vaccines available to combat the flu season, please see the below table outlining what is available from the pharmacy or your medical practitioner.
